

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY C. R. M. MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO



Date - 07th April, 2025

Time - 11:00 A.M

VENUE: Principal Secretray's Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong

The meeting was chaired by Shri P. S. Jahari, ACS, Principal Secretary, NCHAC. Smt. Rebecca Changsan, ACS, Joint Secretary assisted him in the meeting. After welcoming the members the Principal Secretary informed that the meeting would basically discuss review on progress of different departmental schemes by Hon'ble Governor of Assam for Dima Hasao as well as other progresses.. This minutes is for the month April, 2025. Then the discussion continued as shown below:-

SI No.	Department	Points of Discussion
1	Social Welfare	 The Dy. Director, Social Welfare informed that regular visits are being made by DSWO, CDPOs and Supervisors. Monthly reviews at various levels at intra-department capacity viz Sector level, Block level, District level are held.
2	Agriculture	 The DLMC of PMKSY of total 34 beneficiaries covering an area of 36 hq Two Nos. of awareness training program held at Langting village under Maibang ADO Circle and at Diyungbra village under Diyungbra ADO circle where there is possibilities of irrigated cultivation. After training 66 No's of new applications covering an area of about 66 Ha were received from interested beneficiaries whose documents collection were going on for upload in the online portal.
3	A.H & Veterinary	 FMD Vaccination 84.37% completed. PPR Vaccination 87.22% Classical Swine fevers Vaccination(CSF)Round 2(1st.Phase) is ongoing. Classical Swine fevers Vaccination(CSF)Round 2(1st.Phase) is 365 Nos.
4	PWD (R&B)	 The Addl.Chief Engineer has informed that 2 (two) MOS projects are yet to be completed. A total of 7 (seven) flagship projects is going on in Haflong and 3 (three) in Maibang. One DHATC project is not completed.
5	P.H.E	 The Principal Secretary was pleased to know that Dima Hasao came under Top 10 with 86% at FHTC Program under JJM HGJ certification in Maibang need to be improved. SDLL Umrangso need to improve the percentage of water quality tests. Schools/ AWC running water facility need to be improved.
6	Food & Supplies	 The Dy. Director has informed us that Total Nos.of active Lamps is 20Nos. The e-POSE distribution status is good Total Nos.of active FPS is 207 Nos.
7	Fishery	 The Fishery Development Officer has informed that the physical and Financial Progress under PMMSY is good Physical Progress of projects of current year is good.

8	Soil Conservation	 The Addl. Director, Soil informed that the progress of various schemes /project undertaken by them during the financial year 2024-25,like afforestation, Agar plantation, Horticulture plantation,BenchTerracing,Farm pond etc. They also informed the house regarding the water harvesting pond at Miyungkro. Staggered Trenches at ChotoMuolkpi,Boulder revetment at Miyungkro,Water harvesting structure at Jatinga,Goatery at BoroMuolkoi& Piggery at Kapurchera,Water harvesting tank at BoroMoulkoi,Arecanut plantation at Miyungkro,Two days training for SHG at BoroMuolkoi,Sapling distribution at Harangajaoetc.etc.
9	Water Resources	 The Addl. Chief Engineer has given report on erosion caused and anti- erosion measures taken under RIDF XXIX. On being asked about the water bodies in Maibong, the engineer told about the Mahur river, which is mainly used.
10	Irrigation	 The Addl. Chief Engineer has informed that no flagship programs are entrusted to them yet. The Jt. Secretary asked them about the NLCPR scheme and as to when the payment will be done and the work completed.
11	HEALTH	 The JDHS informed the house about the percentage of infants immunization, Percentage of pregnant mothers immunized against the target, Percentage of deaths in the district etc.etc. They placed the 40 indicators with weightage.
12	Co- Operative Societies	 The District Deputy Registrar, Co-Operative Societies informed about Amrit Sarovar in Hatikali Lamps is under progress. Computerization of Lamps is done where Lamps have to enter their transactions daily in the portal. It is a continuous process.
13	EDUCATION	 Since Education Department is given grave interest many Schemes under the Govt.was discussed and the Department was asked to complete the task as soon as possible within the given time. The Jt.Secretary (Education) has precisely put pressure on this.
14	Industries & Commerce	 The Addl. Director has informed that the PMEGP Scheme 28 applications with bank is pending. PMFME scheme 54 is pending. Pm Vishwakarma Scheme 3rd stage clearance 28

Lastly, the Principal Secretary and Secretary, NCHAC, Haflong observed the PPTs of all the departments very minutely and given suggestion to them for further improvement etc. The Principal Secretary also directed to the departments to take early necessary steps to achieve 100% of the target of flagship programms within the end of this Financial year 2024-25.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
