MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY CDC MEETING HELD WITH THE DEPARTMENTS UNDER NCHAC, HAFLONG, DIMA HASAO

DATE - 27th Oct ' 2023

TIME - 1:00 PM

VENUE: Officers' Conference Hall, NCHAC, Haflong

The meeting was chaired by Sri T.T. Daulagupu, ACS, Principal Secretary, NCHAC. The meeting commenced with a slide presentation by Sri P.S. Jahari, ACS, Secretary, NCHAC, basically on activities carried out by Social Welfare Department.

Thereafter, a department-wise brief review of the departmental activities was conducted as follows:-

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Si No.	Name of Department	Points of discussion
1	Social Welfare & Health	 The Principal Secretary exhorted the departments to focus on children's nutrition and to create mass awareness on various govt. schemes so that all genuine beneficiaries are not left out. It was also instructed to focus on Drop out students / Biswakarma Yojana / Special Girl Schemes. All children with special needs are to be certified accordingly for which Social Welfare, Education and Health Departments are to collaborate among themselves. The following instruction was conveyed to the Health Department for strict compliance: To maintain hygiene in the ICU 24x7. To improve the overall cleanliness in the Hospital as well as its surroundings. To establish a separate OPD for AYUSH at the Haflong Civil Hospital. To have a separate OT and permanent Orthopedic Doctor at the Haflong Civil Hospital. The functioning of the Dialysis Centre at Haflong Civil Hospital was found to be satisfactory so far and that it was neat and hygienic. The Principal Secretary requested the Social Welfare deptt. to motivate the ASHA workers so that they may render selfless service and encouraged them to work with more vigour and enthusiasm especially for the upliftment of the downtrodden and poor people and they should focus on nutrition and nutritious food. The Principal Secretary informed that promotion of AYUSH in the entire country was one of the major objectives of the Govt. of India and encouraged the Health deptt. for active participation in all AYUSH
2	Agriculture	activities. The department informed that most of the farmers in the district who are PM KISAN beneficiaries are not having Aadhaar Card. At this, the Principal Secretary directed the department to achieve 100%. It was learnt that some crops grown by the farmers in the district are not certified for which they are facing inconveniences for availing PMFBY. It was decided to approach the competent authority in the govt.
3	P.W.D.	Poor quality of works on Mailu Road implemented by the PWD, Maibang Roads Division under PMGSY was highlighted by the Principal Secretary and the department was directed to ensure that there was no compromise on quality of works done. The department to look into the matter immediately with corrective

4	D.R.D.A.	The meeting expressed satisfaction with regard to the progress of PMAY (G). It was also informed that Aadhaar seeding for MNREGA in the district was only 50.82% for which the Principal Secretary directed the department to take all possible steps to increase the figure.
5	J.J.M.	The district of Dima Hasao recorded an achievement of 50% for which the Principal Secretary encouraged the department to accelerate the works so that 100% achievement could be shown at an early date.
6	Industries	The General Manager, DICC listed the following programmes / schemes of the department:- > PMEGP: It is a credit linked subsidy scheme under which loans can be availed from banks in order to set up manufacturing and service sector units. Subside = 35% of project cost in rural areas and 25% project.
		Subsidy = 35% of project cost in rural areas and 25% project cost in urban areas; Own contribution by Beneficiary = 5% of project cost; Maximum eligible loan amount = 50 Lacs for manufacturing unit and 20 Lacs for service unit; Intended Beneficiaries = Unemployed youth. > Under PMFME Subsidy = 35% of capital expenditure with maximum ceiling of 10 Lacs; Own contribution by Beneficiary = 10% of project cost; Intended Beneficiaries = Food Processing Units. > PM Vishwakarma: It is a Central Sector Scheme launched on 17/09/2023 and is meant for artisans and craftsmen who work with hands & tools. It covers carpentry, boat making, armourer, blacksmith, hammer & toolkit making, locksmith, sculptor, goldsmith, pottery, cobbler, masons, basket making, coir waver, doll & toy making, barber, garland make, washer men, tailor and fishing net makers.
		Features & Benefits: 40 hours basic training; stipend of Rs. 500/day; Toolkit incentive of Rs. 15,000/- one time at the start of basic training; Enterprise Development loan of upto Rs. 3 lacs; Can be applied from the nearest Common Service Centre.
